1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB No. AfDB 752-11-14 of 11th November, 2014 on-line and on the African Development Bank Group's Internet Website (www.afdb.org).
2. The Federal Republic of Nigeria has received Financing from the African Development Bank towards the cost of the Urban Water Sector Reform and Port Harcourt Water Supply and Sanitation Project. It intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the contract for Consulting Services for the Supervision of Works (Water Supply) (EOI No. **PHWSS/AfDB/P-NG-E00-007/CONSULTANCY/SPV**).
3. The objectives of the consultancy assignment are:
 - a) To act as the Engineer to supervise and administer the works following the International Contract Conditions for Consulting Engineers.
 - b) To provide general guidance and issue instructions to contractors and make engineering decisions in consultation with the Client.
 - c) To ensure high quality and cost control of all the works to be executed.
 - d) To ensure that works are executed in full compliance with the engineering design, technical specifications, terms and conditions of the contracts, standard engineering practice, AfDB's safeguards policy and other documents.
 - e) To ensure compliance by works contractor of all social and environmental safeguards provisions including provisions for graduate and labour intensive methods for identified aspects of the works
 - f) To advise the Client on work progress and implementation issues, if any.
 - g) To carry out post-construction services which will consist of activities in the Defects Liability Period.

4. In general, the Consultant shall represent the interest of the Client, vis-à-vis the works contract in any manner related to the works contract and the proper execution thereof.
5. The scope of services to be provided by the Consultant to fulfill the objectives includes but not limited to:
 - a) Supervision and Contract Administration
 - b) Health, Safety and Environment and Safeguards Compliance Monitoring
 - c) Documentation and Reporting
 - d) Post Construction Stage

The works to be supervised are divided into 2 Work Packages of three Lots each as follows:

Package 1

- Rehabilitation of Existing Nos.11 boreholes ,drilling of Nos.8 New 380mm boreholes (380mm dia) and laying of 2.3km raw water line at Rumuola.
- Laying of 600m transmission line (Rumuola-EWT), and 130km distribution lines (Rumuola) + meters.
- Construction of 1500m³ EWT, 2000m³ GWT , 3000m³ GLT and rehabilitation of existing EWT and GLT at Rumuola.
- Supply and installation of new pumps ,rehabilitation of existing pump houses and construction of generator buildings at Rumuola
- Construction of new treatment, clear water tank and high-lift plant, and laboratory at Rumuola.
- Lining and diversion of existing drain at Rumuola
- Power Supply Sub-Station at Rumuola
- Construction of sewage collection and disposal system (earth works 1605m²) at Rumuola
- Refurbishment of existing buildings at Rumuola

Package 2

- Laying of 91.84km of transmission (Diobu-Moscow) and distribution lines (Moscow) + meters
 - Laying of 115.54km of transmission (Diobu-Borokiri) and distribution lines (Borokiri) + meters
 - Laying of 170.9kms of transmission (Rumuola-Diobu) and distribution lines (Diobu) + meters
 - Construction of 650m³ EWT and rehabilitation of existing EWT at Moscow Station
 - Rehabilitation of existing 500m³ EWT at Borikiri Station
 - Construction of 500m³ EWT, rehabilitation existing EWT and rehabilitation of existing Ground Level Tank (GLT) at Diobu Station.
 - Construction of guard house, chlorine dosing building at Moscow, Borokiri and Diobu
 - Construction of pump house, Admin Building, residential building for operators at Diobu
 - Rehabilitation of existing buildings at Moscow, Borikiri and Diobu
 - Provision of Power Supply Sub-station at Diobu Station
6. The Port Harcourt Water Corporation (PHWC) hereinafter referred to as "The Implementing Agency" now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
 7. A consultant shall submit only one proposal, either individually or as a joint venture partner. If a consultant, including a joint venture partner, submits or participates in more than one proposal, all such proposals shall be disqualified.

8. International Consultants may associate with Local firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy.
9. Interested firms must organize their Expression of Interest in the following order:
 - a) Company Profile/Brochure including Legal Status (Certificate of Incorporation), Letter of intent of Association, if necessary, Organizational chart, list of Board of Directors, and beneficial ownership.
 - b) Experience in similar assignments in the last ten years with the following details: costs (for works and services), scope and nature, duration, place, status (lead or Partner) etc.
 - c) Skills: List of relevant staff, employment status including staff in payroll and independent consultant, and years of relevant experience. Indicative personnel profile should include but not limited to the following: Team leader, Resident Engineer, Hydrologist, Contract Specialist, Quantity Surveyor, Social Safeguard/Gender Specialist, Geodetic Engineer, Electrical Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Hydraulic Engineer and Civil/ Structural Engineer
10. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method set out in the African Development Bank Rules and Procedures for the Use of Consultants Revised 2012.
